Did You Know? Behavioral Health (BH) Respite, a New OhioRISE Service, Can Be Provided by Family Members, Neighbors, and Foster Care Providers!

BH Respite is intended to provide short-term, temporary relief to the primary caregiver of an OhioRISE plan enrolled child or youth. This new service is designed to support and preserve the primary caregiving relationship.

How can an OhioRISE BH Respite provider help?



- By supporting the child or youth in a home and in community-based settings.
- By assisting the child or youth with their daily activities.
- By transporting the child or youth within the community while providing respite activities to support the youth.

Who can become an OhioRISE BH Respite provider?

It takes a team to wrap care around OhioRISE children, youth, and their families! Eligible providers of BH Respite services are flexible. In addition to typical eligible providers like community behavioral health and developmental disabilities providers, OhioRISE BH Respite can be done by family, neighbors, and other natural supports.

ODM and the Buckeye Ranch Engage with Youth and Families at the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Ohio Youth and Family Summit

Attendees included youth, parents, caregivers, and providers from across the state.
