OhioRISE Care Coordinator Helps Member and Their Family Stabilize Their Immediate Needs, Identify Ongoing Needs, and Build a Strong Child and Family Team!

An OhioRISE member and their family were identified as being in danger of losing their housing. The member's care coordinator promptly took action to address the family's immediate needs by connecting with a housing case manager from another local agency. The care coordinator and housing case manager successfully worked together to stabilize the family's immediate housing needs. With housing in place, the young person and their family were able to shift their focus and begin to work with the OhioRISE care coordinator on identifying their ongoing behavioral health needs, making referrals, and scheduling behavioral health and physical health appointments. The care coordinator is also working with the member to build a strong child and family team including the member's close family, treatment providers, and the local housing agency.

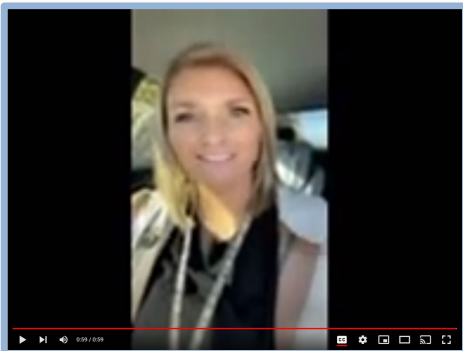

The Child and Adolescent Behavioral Health Center of Excellence Has Launched The New CANS Learning Community!

The CANS learning community provides a place for Ohio CANS assessors to develop their competency and refine their practice. Each session includes 10-15-minutes of learning on advanced technical content designed to enhance skills development. Afterwards, the group will engage in reflective practice, field-based questions and answers, and peer-to-peer group learning.

Sessions are offered on the fourth Thursday of each month from 9-10 a.m. While it is not mandatory to attend each session, the learning community topics do build on one another.
