

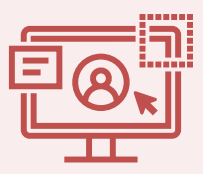

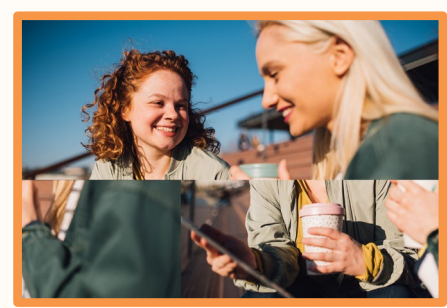
### Impact Spotlight

#### OhioRISE System of Care Supports Ohio Youth and Family Experiencing Immediate Health Need

Recently, an OhioRISE youth and their family experienced an immediate mental health need, and the local OhioRISE system of care stepped in to assure the youth's and family's safety and well-being.

After receiving outreach from the family in need, OhioRISE community providers, including the local care management entity (CME) and Family and Children First (FCF) council quickly came together with their state counterparts to address the immediate needs of this youth and their family. These groups coordinated the necessary services and supports that helped the family stay stable and avoid relinquishing custody to the child protection system.

OhioRISE continues to grow local systems of care that have relationships and processes in place for organizations to react quickly and bring solutions to families and caregivers across Ohio. Thank you to our OhioRISE community partners for supporting Ohio's youth and their families in navigating complex systems!

- Propose and review quality improvement activities and population health improvement projects.
- Provide input to about the development, implementation, and outcomes in a publicly available report card for providers serving OhioRISE members.
- Provide specific input to improve and enhance outreach to members and their families to educate them about available services, and to help them access care.
