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### Will You Provide OhioRISE Services? Select OhioRISE Provider Specialties Now!

The Ohio Medicaid next generation managed care entities (MCEs) are building their provider networks in preparation for the program's July 1, 2022 go-live. When you enroll and add the appropriate specialties to your provider enrollment information, you help members make an informed decision in selecting a managed care organization (MCO) that best meets their healthcare and preferred provider needs. Additionally, adding the

appropriate specialties to your provider enrollment before July 1st will allow for prompt billing and claims payment after go-live.

As of March 9th, several new provider specialties associated with the implementation of the OhioRISE program are available to you. ODM requires that providers add a provider specialty to their provider enrollment type in order to bill for some new and enhanced services under the OhioRISE program. **Enrolled Providers:** If you are currently enrolled as an ODM provider, plan to offer any of the new and enhanced services, and have the appropriate certification/documentation, please email ODM at [Medicaid\\_Provider\\_Update@medicaid.ohio.gov](mailto:Medicaid_Provider_Update@medicaid.ohio.gov) **as soon as possible**. Request that the applicable specialty for the new service be added to your existing provider type and attach required documentation.

**New Providers:** If you are a provider who is not currently enrolled in the Ohio Medicaid program, and wish to enroll to provide any services under the next generation of Ohio Medicaid, please visit the following link to the Ohio Medicaid online application: <https://portal.ohmits.com/Public/Providers/Enrollment/tabId/49/Default.aspx>. If your enrollment requests the addition of more than one specialty, after your enrollment is complete, please email ODM at [Medicaid\\_Provider\\_Update@medicaid.ohio.gov](mailto:Medicaid_Provider_Update@medicaid.ohio.gov) to submit the required documentation for the new specialties.

**What's Ahead:** In late spring, ODM's provider enrollment systems will be unavailable while the state converts to its new modular Ohio Medicaid Enterprise System (OMES). During the conversion, new provider enrollments will pause and specialties cannot be added until the new system is operational on July 1. Additional details on specific blackout dates are forthcoming.
