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Will You Provide OhioRISE Services? Select OhioRISE Provider Specialties Now!

Since March 9, several new provider specialties associated with the implementation of the OhioRISE program are available to you. ODM requires that providers add a provider specialty to their provider enrollment type in order to bill for some new and enhanced services under this program and part of the next generation of Ohio Medicaid, which begins July 1, 2022. Enrolled Providers: If you are currently enrolled as an ODM provider, plan to offer any of the new and enhanced services, and have the appropriate certification/documentation, please email ODM at Medicaid_Provider_Update@medicaid.ohio.gov **as soon as possible**. Request that the applicable specialty for the new service be added to your existing provider type and attach required documentation.

New Providers: If you are a provider who is not currently enrolled in the Ohio Medicaid Program, and wish to enroll to provide any services under the next generation of Medicaid, please visit the following link to the Ohio Medicaid online application: <https://portal.ohmits.com/Public/Providers/Enrollment/tabId/49/Default.aspx>. If your enrollment requests the addition of more than one specialty, after your enrollment is complete, please email ODM at Medicaid_Provider_Update@medicaid.ohio.gov to submit the required documentation for the new specialties.

The managed care entities (MCEs) are building their provider networks for the Next Generation program's July 1 go-live. When you enroll and add the appropriate specialties to your provider enrollment information, you will help members make an informed decision while selecting a managed care organization (MCO) during open enrollment. This will allow for prompt billing and claims payment after go-live. **In late spring, ODM's provider enrollment systems will be unavailable while the state converts to its new modular system. During the conversion, new provider enrollments will stop and specialties cannot be added until the new system is operational on July 1.**

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Information for DODD and ODA Providers

DODD and ODA missions align closely with Medicaid priorities, allowing ODM to fund many of the services and supports you provide to Ohioans we serve. We continue to work together to simplify and streamline provider administrative responsibilities in anticipation of the launch of the next generation Ohio Medicaid program on July 1. 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Provider Network Management & Centralized Credentialing Training Coming Soon!

As a part of the next generation of Ohio’s Medicaid managed care program, the new Provider Network Management (PNM) Module and Centralized Credentialing initiative will include customized user training available through a variety of channels to provide learning for all user types including:

Type	Description
E-learning/On-Demand Trainings	Web-based learning and digital collaboration. Includes the delivery of content via Internet, audio and video, text, pictures, and more. Recorded (video + audio) of course.
Classroom Instructor-Led Training	Two-way, interactive classroom-style training lead by an instructor. Sessions will utilize a mix of presentation, demonstration, hands-on practice, and training materials.
Virtual Classrooms	Seminar-style trainings hosted through a call-in host like WebEx or Zoom.
Desk Reference Guides	Detailed description of the steps to achieve the end goal. Covers all functions available within the system. Used as a desk reference for each individual user group written in a fashion that will be easy to consume by all audiences.
Quick Reference Guide	Provides quick reference information primarily conveyed via screenshots and concise, numbered callouts.
