The Columbus Dispatch published an article on August 31, 2022, featuring the story of the Nine family, whose son is enrolled in OhioRISE. The Nine family reported they were often overwhelmed with trying to coordinate care for their son and having to retell their story to multiple providers prior to enrollment in OhioRISE. Now, their OhioRISE care coordinator is centralizing their child's care and pulling their team together, lifting part of the heavy burden this family has carried for years.

“[OhioRISE] improves past situations where parents had to give up custody of their children to the state in order to get the required, expensive mental health and residential care needed by a child with severe behavioral problems,” the article states.
