#### CMEs Initial Engagement with Family Success Story

 A CME care coordinator reported the following story after a successful initial engagement with an OhioRISE member's family.

The care coordinator knew the family from a previous clinical role, in which she had worked with them until the child was determined to need a higher level of care. When the care coordinator reached out, the mother had already received the Aetna OhioRISE welcome packet, so the coordinator walked her through the materials and explained the program. Upon hearing about OhioRISE, the mother exclaimed, "Oh my gosh! You mean they are finally doing something like this! Child's name (*redacted*) will be a test person for the program? That's good because you know she and our family will help work out all the kinks!" The mother was thrilled to work with the care coordinator again. She felt at peace knowing she wouldn't have to start all over with someone new and wouldn't have to retell her child and family's story.
