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### **Learn about OhioRISE Care Management Entities (CMEs)!**



Resilience through  
Integrated Systems and Excellence

On February 17, Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) Director Maureen Corcoran announced the 20 regional care management entities (CMEs) that will launch OhioRISE, Ohio's first-ever integrated program to help children who have complex and serious behavioral health needs. OhioRISE (Resilience through Integrated Systems and Excellence) is part of Ohio's next generation of managed care. It will feature intensive care coordination, new and enhanced behavioral health services and will offer a new Medicaid waiver program that will help families prevent custody relinquishment.

The OhioRISE CMEs are community-based organizations that serve as the go-to resource for delivering care coordination to children and youth enrolled in OhioRISE living in a certain geographic area. They will also build community resources to grow the system of care within the geographic area that they serve.
