### Impact Spotlight

#### Dedication and Tenacity Lead to Successful Engagement of Family and Youth

This week, a CME reported that with persistence, they successfully engaged the caregiver of a youth with complex behavioral health and multisystem needs to consider how OhioRISE could benefit their family.

During the CME care coordinator's initial phone contact with the youth's caregiver, the caregiver was hesitant and declined OhioRISE care coordination, but requested that the care coordinator send them the [OhioRISE brochure](#). The care coordinator followed up with another phone call but was unable to contact the caregiver. Understanding the caregiver felt overwhelmed and fearful after being refused services by multiple providers, the care coordinator visited the



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caregiver in their home. The caregiver's parent coach happened to be at the home and encouraged the caregiver to engage with the CME care coordinator. After learning about how OhioRISE could benefit their family, the caregiver agreed to have a CANS assessment scheduled and begin care coordination. With the caregiver's support, the care coordinator was able to contact the facility in which the youth was placed to obtain the information they needed to move forward!
